Cultural Notes

Daylilies prefer full sun, but half day's sun will suffice. Daylilies can bloom for up to six months once established. Enrich the soil with lots of compost and well rotted manure. Spread the roots out and cover with soil, the crown should be just below ground level. Water well to settle the plants in, then a good watering once a week in dry weather. Mulching is very beneficial. Plant approximately 45 - 60 cm apart, and avoid planting in the hottest time of the year. Fertilise in Spring and again in Autumn. A monthly foliar feed with Nitrosol or Seagrow will improve performance.

SEEDLINGS FROM OWN HYBRIDISING

I have been hybridising daylilies for three years, and have used only the very latest cultivars that not only represent significant breaks, but have excellent plant habits (high bud count, rebloom ability, etc). These seedlings are graded after blooming, are planted in 3.5 litre plastic bags, and are often 2 fans in a bag. They are priced as follows:

- 1. Highest Grade:** R 25.00 each. These are as good as many of the best and latest cultivars. Lots of eyes and edges in the mix.
- 2. Middle Grade:** R 17.00 each. These are pretty flowers, of mixed colours, and certainly more beautiful than common landscaping varieties.
- 3. Garden Grade:** R 10.00 each. These are nice flowers, of mixed colours, and are ideal for use in a large landscape area.
